

7-11 Holdup

RULES: IDPA

COURSE DESIGNER: Stage 10, 2007 Master's IDPA Championship, Birmingham, AL, by Ron Holland.

START POSITION: Standing at P1, one palm on each drum.

SCENARIO: You are caught working behind the counter at the local 7-11 when 3 gangsters attempt a murder. You shoot them to their knees, then have to finish with head shots.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Engage the standing threats, T1-T3, with 2 rounds each in Tactical Sequence. Then take cover behind drums and engage the kneeling threats, T4-T6, with 2 rounds each in Tactical Priority from either side of drums. Go prone on opposite side of drums and engage the prone threats, T7-T9, from cover in Tactical Priority with one round to each head.

SCORING: Vickers Count
RD COUNT: 15 minimum
TARGETS: 9 IDPA
TARGET DISTANCE: 7 yards
SCORED HITS: Best 2 on T1-T6, head shot required on T7-T9
START-STOP: Audible – Last shot
PENALTIES: As per IDPA rules
CONCEALED CARRY: Required
SPECIAL NOTES: No FTN on T7-T9, but only head shots will be scored. Missed head shot will score -5.
