

A Day at the Beach

RULES: IDPA

COURSE DESIGNER: Lin Edwards

START POSITION: Seated in beach chair, reading book held in both hands.

SCENARIO: You are enjoying a day at the beach, your handgun & reloads concealed inside a folded towel on the sand beside you. Two BG's sic their Rottweiler on you just for fun. After you deal with their vicious dog, they produce guns and aim them at you.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Retrieve your weapon from the towel and engage T1 with 2 rds. to the body and 1 to the head. Then engage T2-T3 in Tactical Sequence (1-2-1) with 2 rds. to the body and then re-engage with 1 rd. to the head on each.

SCORING: Vickers Count
RD COUNT: 9 minimum
TARGETS: 3 IDPA
TARGET DISTANCE: 2-15 yards
SCORED HITS: Best 2(body)-1(head)
START-STOP: Audible – Last shot
PENALTIES: As per IDPA rules
CONCEALED CARRY: Not Required
