

Attack Dog

RULES: IDPA

COURSE DESIGNER: From the 2001 Georgia State IDPA Match (modified by Lin Edwards)

START POSITION: Shooter at P1 facing downrange with hands at sides.

Scenario: You are walking in the woods when you get too close to someone's marijuana patch and he sics his attack dog on you. You get fleeting shots as the dog charges through the trees. The dog's owner then aims a rifle at you after you shoot his dog.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Engage targets T-1 to T-6 in that order (simulating 1 charging dog) with at least 1 shot each – then engage T7 with 6 shots from cover.

SCORING: Vickers Count

RD COUNT: 12 minimum

SCORED HITS: *Best 1 on T1-T6; Best 6 on T7.

***NOTE:** T1-T6 must have cumulative total of at least 4 points to neutralize.

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: As per IDPA rules.
