

An Evening Stroll

RULES: IDPA

COURSE DESIGNER: Lin Edwards

START POSITION: Shooter at P1 facing downrange with hands at side.

SCENARIO: You are out for an evening stroll when you come upon a gang of punks annoying a neighbor lady and her two children. When you tell them to leave her alone, two of them point weapons at you. After you deal with the first two, others using the neighbors for cover, start threatening them and shoot at you.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Engage T1 & T2 in Tactical Priority with at least 2 rounds each while moving to, or from behind cover. Then engage the moving steel plates (Texas Star) behind the non-threats. Use cover and reload according to IDPA rules.

SCORING: Vickers Count
RD COUNT: 9 minimum
TARGETS: 2 IDPA, 3 NT, TxStar
TARGET DISTANCE: 10 – 12 yards
SCORED HITS: Best 2 on IDPA, steel must fall
START-STOP: Audible – Last shot
PENALTIES: As per IDPA rules
CONCEALED CARRY: Required
SPECIAL NOTES: If the Tx Star stops with one or more plates concealed, FTN will not apply, just the -5 pts. per plate.
