

ATM Robbery #1206

RULES: IDPA

COURSE DESIGNER: Randy Masters, modified by Lin Edwards

START POSITION: Shooter at P1 with back to targets and hands on ATM shelf.

SCENARIO: You are at the local bank branch using the walkup ATM. It is Friday after work and there are others needing dinner money behind you in the parking lot waiting to use the ATM. You hear a voice behind you say “Give me your money or you are dead.” A gunshot rings out and the bullet strikes the wall beside you.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, turn and engage targets **T1 & T2** w/2 rds. each in **Tactical Sequence** (1-2-1) then engage **T3** w/2 rds from P1 or while moving to cover at P2. Targets **T4-T6** must be engaged from behind low cover at P2. Any IDPA legal reload may be used. **DO NOT** shoot over the top of the barrel.

SCORING: Vickers Count
RD COUNT: 12 minimum
TARGETS: 6 IDPA, 2 NT
TARGET DISTANCE: 3 – 7 yards
SCORED HITS: Best 2 on paper
START/STOP: Audible/Last shot
PENALTIES: As per IDPA rules
CONCEALED CARRY: Required
SPECIAL NOTES: At least one knee must be on ground when utilizing low cover at P2.
