

Help Gone Bad

RULES: IDPA

COURSE DESIGNER: Lin Edwards

START POSITION: Facing downrange, hands on counter, loaded weapon on shelf.

SCENARIO: You are helping a friend by running his convenience store while he must be out of town. You are waiting on a customer when bad guys enter and pull guns and start shooting. Fortunately your friend has armored the inside front of the counter.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, retrieve your weapon from the shelf and engage T1 with at least 3 rounds. Then take cover with 1 knee (or both) on the ground and engage the remaining targets in Tactical Priority, with 3 rounds each, from around either side of the counter.

SCORING: Vickers Count
RD COUNT: 12 minimum
TARGETS: 4 IDPA, 1 NT
TARGET DISTANCE: 1-7 yards
SCORED HITS: Best 3 on paper
START-STOP: Audible – Last shot
PENALTIES: As per IDPA rules
CONCEALED CARRY: Not required
