

Hit and no run

RULES: IDPA

COURSE DESIGNER: Lin Edwards

START POSITION: Shooter seated in drivers seat with both hands on steering wheel.

SCENARIO: You are leaving for home after watching the fireworks downtown when a child darts out of the crowd. You bump her with your car and she falls down in front of your car. Several people emerge from the crowd and pick up rocks. They break out your window, and try to drag you out of the car.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Engage targets T1-T5 with 2 rounds each in Tactical Priority (near to far). Be careful when you draw. Do not point your weapon at any part of your body. Do not shoot the car door!

SCORING: Vickers Count
RD COUNT: 10 minimum
TARGETS: 5 IDPA
TARGET DISTANCE: 1 – 6 yards
SCORED HITS: Best 2 on paper
START-STOP: Audible – Last shot
PENALTIES: As per IDPA rules
CONCEALED CARRY: Required
